NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

All races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, (RRS), except as provided in the Desert Regatta Sailing Instructions and as prescribed by the One Design or Association Class rules.

ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to all Portsmouth One Design classes. Three boats in any class will warrant their own start.

Online registration is available at http://www.cbsc.info/desert_regatta.html, with fees being accepted online via credit card. Registration will be accepted onsite during registration hours. However, advance registration is strongly encouraged.

Eight races are scheduled. The number of races sailed may change depending on local conditions. No races will be started after 1400 on Sunday.

PRIZES

ACCOMMODATIONS

There are several hotels in the area. Tent and RV camping with hot showers and electricity is available in the Charbonneau campground. The park opens at 6:00 am, and closes at 10:00 pm. Reservations are strongly encouraged and can be made at www.recreation.gov. A limited number of sites have been reserved for the regatta and can be purchased by contacting Doug Queen at dfgueen@charter.net. Camp site are \$60.00 for two nights.

Additional camping is available <u>Hood Park</u>, located just down river from Charbonneau.
